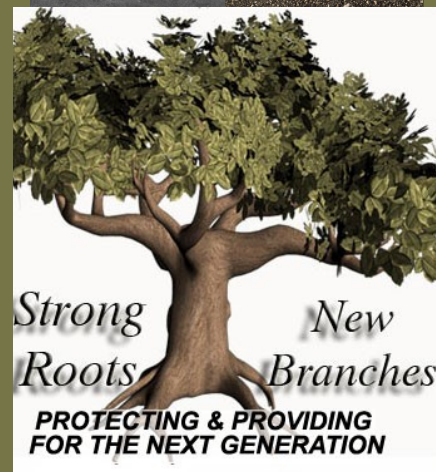
We've been blessed with some beautiful days this Fall here at Grand Oaks !
